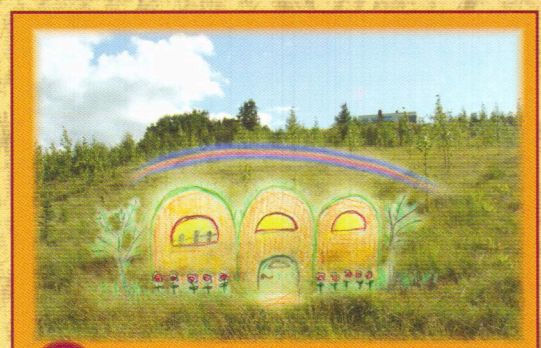


1 The hill from the center of Aukureyri south towards the Skating Hall is populated by the hidden people. Their houses have windows which look like they were made of stained glass and it appears that the houses are sentient and are holding hands.



9 In the most northern part of Kotárgerði there are hidden people who are kind and helpful.

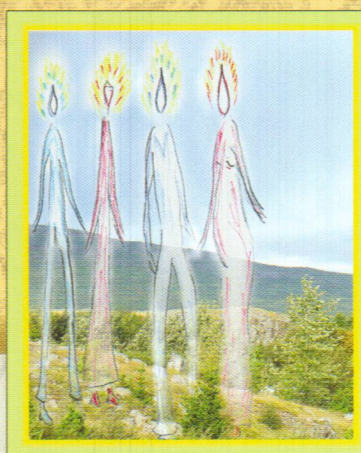


8 The northern part of Stekkjargerði is populated by chubby earth gnomes and elves. They do not have much contact with each other.



Light-elves are seen out in the wilderness. They are delicate, half transparent, thin, with long limbs and they have a large star in their forehead. They resemble the winter-elves.

11 In the glen of Kotárgil by Dalsbraut we find a variety of fun-loving and lively beings. There are elves, dwarfs and earth gnomes, which belong to highest area of our worldly sphere and the lowest planes of the mental sphere. The hidden people live in the rocks. If you want to connect with these beings you should sit down on a rock and listen to the sounds of nature. Sit, listen and feel the tone of nature resound with your inner tone and then you will see, hear and experience.

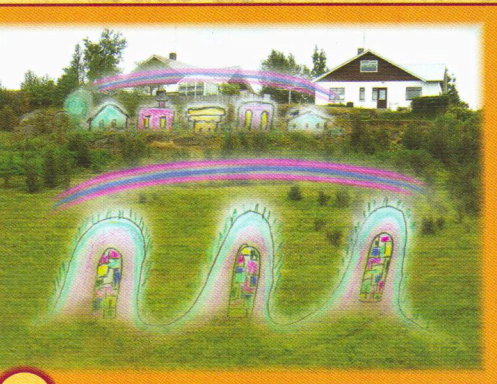


The Long-legs are seen up in the mountains. They are special beings, very thin, with a long trunk, spindly legs and a long neck. They are easily felt, but seldom seen.



16 Ásbýrgi near the bottom of the horseshoe. The beings that live here do not see each other, but yet they individually connect with the humans that come to the area. The earth gnomes connect with the children, the dwarves with the elderly and the elves communicate with people of all ages.

14 If you look up the glen in Glerárgil you can see many large double doors on your right. The doors are red and green in turn. Here are holy hidden beings who are very quiet and dignified. On the left towards south are high and narrow doors. Behind them live the Long-legs, tall and serious beings. In this area one should move slowly and with respect so as not to disturb these beings.



10 Kringlumyrarklappir. The dwelling of earth gnomes and in the hill below is the abode of the hidden people.



Grass-elves are tiny and it is fun to see them wake up in spring as the grass gets green. They grow with the grass and fall asleep in autumn.



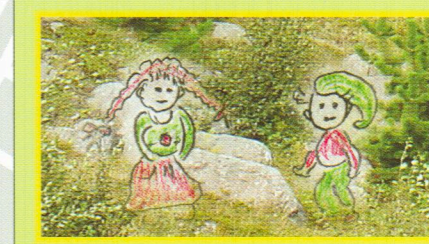
The goddess of growth and fauna sends her divine servants throughout the land, here is one of them.



Undines are seen hovering over lakes and rivers. Mostly as dancing beings in the likeness of children with finely textured wings.



By the University there are merry gnomes in bright and colourful clothing. They smile and waive if they feel they are being observed.



The gnomes are usually tiny but can „be up to 10“ cm long. Their dwellings beautifully adorned and there they keep their cribs and baby-chairs, for when they become old and bed-ridden they start to age in reverse.



15 In Ásbýrgi there are small houses in the rocks and the hillock north of the bottom. Here we have dwarfs and earth gnomes living in separate dimensions. To experience them, lie down between their houses and try to relax. You will hear chatter that slowly becomes louder but do not expect to understand what they are saying. These beings are hilarious!



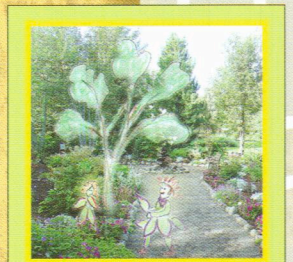
3 In Lækjargil there are hidden people on both sides of the glen in buildings that look like old Icelandic turf houses. Smoke wafts from the chimneys and the smell is a blend of food and burning peat.



Of all the beings that surround us the hidden people resemble us the most. Usually they dress as we did in the 19th century.



Angels come in all sizes. They are seen over hospitals, geriatric institutions and kindergartens. Whenever there are prayers for help they appear.



Tree-beings are as varied as the species of trees. Some beings reflect the soul of the tree, others hibernate in the trunk over winter, then fly between the branches with the coming of spring.



5 The old rock mine by the river Glerá. Here are elves the size of ten year olds and their clothes and dwellings are very colourful. They are often seen playing games. You can sit down in the hillside and focus your attention until you reach a quiet spot inside yourself. Observe the images that appear in front of your mind's eye.



2 The chapels by the graveyards are like glass-flowers which can extend or close their petals. The souls of those who are about to leave earth stay there while their bodies await burial. There are three chapels in the area: by the Akureyri-graveyard, the graveyard of the church of Lögmannshlíð and one situated above town which is used by the elves and the hidden people.



6 In the Public Park and Botanical Gardens there are many species of tree and flower elves. Some resemble children others are like butterflies. The tree sprites are remarkable beings, one lives in each tree and disappears into the trunk for a long sleep as winter approaches. There are little gnomes in the branches of the firs and pines, -something worth noting when you select a Christmas tree! Try to look around with unfocused eyes and allow the vision to come. What do you see?



4 In a small hillock south of Eikarlundur the elves live in strange houses that look like flowers on brick-stilts. The overall effect is that the houses resemble giant balloons. The inhabitants are happy creatures, gentle and playful.

THE HIDDEN WORLDS OF AKUREYRI

The Hidden Worlds are a manifestation of nature's essence. Nature and all creation exist on manifold levels of the frequency spectrum and they are governed by the Grand Architect of all existence. Let us enjoy the treasures of life and experience the simple truth that you, I, the land, nature and the entire planet are but one. In every domestic garden there are tree sprites, flower fairies and grass-elves. Beings may inhabit rocks and there are earth gnomes in small houses that have the outward appearance of small stones or pebbles. Go gently through your property as it houses more beings than just you and yours.



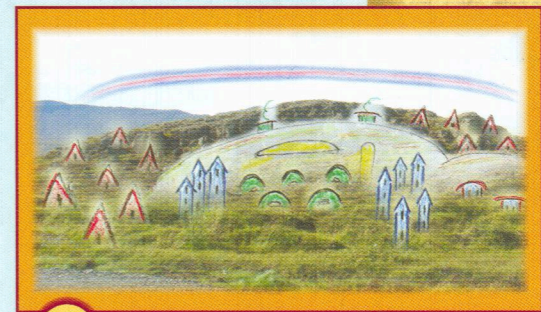
18 In Bárufellsklappir there is a community of hidden people, elves and earth gnomes. These beings go fishing like the humans.



The beach-lurkers resemble seals for a while, then they go through rapid transformations from fins to tail, often having more than one head. They are grey and brown and their aura is dull.



13 By the University there are green buildings with red windows and what looks like a glass wall. The beings who live there are a happy lot, playing around, jumping and singing. But you should approach them quietly, close your eyes or unfocus them and experience the atmosphere.



19 In Krossanesborgir there are five species of elves, hidden people and gnomes. The area is much populated in many dimensions and the houses are colourful and ornamented.



7 In the hill below Sigurhæðir there are many species of beings: hidden people, elves, dwarfs, earth gnomes, flower fairies, small undines and tree sprites. These beings exist on different frequencies and do not see each other. But you may be able to experience or see the varied dimensions.



17 Golden city walls by Sjónarhóll. The abode of refined and colourful elves. If you want to connect to them try an improvised song and they will answer back.



12 The bell on the hill. There one sees the blue arches of faith and fidelity. The union of the area is mirrored in the concord of the bell. Earth gnomes reside under the bell in buildings that resemble those of Atlantis.
