## **Akureyri Town and Infrastructure:**

- \* New Tunnel has been opened through the mountain Vaðlaheiði on the opposite side of the fjord from Akureyri. The tunnel makes the driving between Akureyri and the East of Iceland to e.g. Húsavík, Mývatn and Egilsstaðir much safer and approx. 15 km shorter. The Tunnel which is about 7 km long, has been under construction since 2013 and was officially opened in January 2019. - \* Hlíðarfjall Ski Area A new chairlift will be added to the area winter (2019/2020) in connection to the existing chairlift, adding 1100 meters further up the mountain. By then the area will have 8 lifts in total. Web: hlidarfjall.is
- \* The Seafront path in Akureyri walking/bicycle path along the seaside from airport to town center, a new bridge on the path was opened summer 2018 called "the Rendezvous Bridge". Popular e.g. for photography, angling and walks.

#### \* Red heart traffic light

All red traffic lights in Akureyri are heart shaped and visitors tend to like to catch a photo of them — In order to make it safe for them to catch a photo in a safe way - a red traffic light has been put down by the waterfront close to Hof Cultural House. An ideal spot for taking selfies, safe from the traffic, with Akureyri Church in the background.

#### \* History-signs

Akureyri town has been creating a trail with information boards – telling the towns history and history of buildings and streets. The Trail leads from the Old Town to the Town Center and summer 2018 the trail continued down to the Cruise ship harbor at Oddeyrarbryggja – from the town square at Ráðhústorg along the Strandgata which is the steet along the coast line down to the harbor.

## \* New hiking trail along the town's river Glerá

A new trail has been constructed along the canyon of the river Glerá along the west side of the river from the new hydropower plant – leading up to a dam in the Glerárdalur valley some 7 km. This trail connects with the current path along the canyon down to the mouth of the river

# **Transportation**

## \* Direct Domestic flight between Keflavík to Akureyri

Air Iceland Connect offers direct domestic flights between Keflavik International Airport (KEF) and Akureyri (AEY) North Iceland in connection to international flights via Keflavik. Flights are available 4 times a week on Mondays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.

Flights are only available in connection with international flights through Keflavik Airport (KEF), a stopover in KEF is not allowed and passengers cannot leave the terminal between flights as customs clearance on arriving passengers is performed at Akureyri. The flight to Akureyri is only available in connection with same-day international flights through Keflavik Airport (KEF). If traveling with Icelandair to Keflavík the baggage is checked in all the way to Akureyri. If traveling with another airline to Keflavík Airport. Then customers need to go to baggage claim, pick up the luggage and check in again to Akureyri at the IGS service desk, just by the baggage belts.
